## Sewer Spill Impacts Dyes Inlet

*"No Contact" Advisory Issued for Shellfish and Recreational Use*

**BREMERTON** — The Health District is issuing a 5-day "No Contact" advisory for marine waters in northern portion of Dyes Inlet. A sewage spill located at the head of Dyes Inlet at Silverdale discharged an estimated 20,000 gallons of untreated sewage directly into Dyes Inlet. The "no contact" area is located north of a line between the Tracyton boat launch and the Chico boat launch. This advisory includes both recreational contact, such as waterskiing, and shellfish harvesting in this area. The Health District is posting warning signs at public access points in the closure area. The Health District has an ongoing advisory against collecting shellfish in a portion of this area already in place.
