Potential Service Interruptions for Online Septic System Records, March 16 - 20

BREMERTON, WA — The public may experience intermittent service interruptions next week (March 16-20) when trying to obtain septic system records through the Health District's website. The Health District is switching to a different software program to manage the estimated 60,000 septic system permit records for Kitsap County.

Although the service interruptions should be intermittent and short-term in nature, the timing of the interruptions may be inconvenient to the public. If anyone experiences one of these interruptions while trying to access septic system records, they should either try again in a couple of hours, or call the Health District at (360) 337-5285 and request the records to be sent by email.

The change in software will save the Health District approximately \$27,000/year in maintenance and service fees, and will provide better service to anyone accessing septic system records through the District's website. This change is made possible by a grant from the Washington State Department of Health with additional funding from the Kitsap County Surface and Storm Water Management Program.
