Hansville Repair is on the cutting edge of waste reduction and pollution prevention. The shop has been a five-star EnviroStars business since June of 1997, and was the second business in Kitsap County to receive EnviroStars certification. Allen and Lynda Otto purchased Hansville Repair in 2001 and they are building on the environmental record of previous owner Chip Keen. The Ottos are committed to their community and taking care of the environment. “Environmental responsibility is an important part of supporting our beautiful community,” says Lynda Otto.

Employees at Hansville Repair receive paid training and incentives to reduce waste. In addition, all inventory purchases are made with waste reduction in mind.

A specially designed boiler heats the building with waste oil generated by repair work and customers. Freon, antifreeze, used oil filters, lead wheel weights, tire casings, mop water, and batteries are all recycled. Hansville Repair is a Green Works member for their solid waste recycling efforts.

The shop completely eliminated chlorinated solvents to remove the risk of cross-contamination that would create more hazardous

waste. Other product substitutions such as using aqueous brake cleaner rather than hazardous solvents, have helped Hansville Repair reduce exposure risks to employees and the environment. The shop also provides secondary containment for all liquid wastes and has spill control kits nearby.

Hansville Repair’s aggressive pollution prevention efforts have been recognized both regionally and statewide. In 1997, they received a Waste Information Network Award and in 1998, they were recognized by Washington Governor Gary Locke with a Governor’s Award for Outstanding Achievement in Pollution Prevention.
