Congratulations to Tim and Mary Piecuch, owners of Kingston Collision & Glass for recently being upgrade to a **5 star** EnviroStars business.

Tim started the business in 2003, but before he began providing service to customers he contacted several State and local agencies to be sure he had all the necessary environmental requirements and permits in place.

Kingston Collision & Glass has a spray paint booth permitted through the Puget Sound Clean Air Agency. The shop uses high volume low pressure spraying equipment to minimize overspray and waste. The shop cleans and prepares the surface of vehicles with a low volatile organic cleaner that is safer for the environment. A self-contained sand blaster is also used for paint removal as well as dust free sanding systems that reduce the generation of styrene and polyester resins.

Tim has taken additional measures to protect the environment by providing the shop with a spill kit and secondary containers for storing waste as well as preparing a written spill response plan.

Kingston Collision & Glass properly manages all their hazardous waste, and has an extensive recycling program. This includes recycling scrap metal, batteries, bumpers, covers, paper, and cardboard.
