By managing hazardous wastes properly, Liberty Bay Auto Center is an example for other auto shops to follow. The shop protects water quality by storing wastes such as antifreeze and oil filters in a covered and contained area of the shop, ensuring that hazardous materials do not enter the storm drain. Also, dirty water from washing vehicles is treated through the sanitary sewer system rather than discharged into the storm drain.

All used oil is siphoned into a double-walled container, eliminating the danger of spillage and leakage. Liberty Bay contracts with licensed hazardous waste companies to handle wastes such as solvents and carburetor cleaner, and the shop recycles antifreeze, batteries, freon refrigerants (from air conditioning systems), metal, radiators, condensers, and paper products such as cardboard and office paper.

Service manager Bill Stuart has taken extra steps to prevent pollution, reduce waste, and provide a safe environment for his

employees. Pump sprayers are used instead of aerosol cans. This method is more efficient, creates less waste, and saves money. Monthly safety meetings and a hazard communication plan keep employees informed about hazardous materials and safety issues. Liberty Bay has eliminated chlorinated brake cleaning products, which are harmful to the environment and to employee health.
