Owners Debbie and Larry Goodwin have switched the shop's solvent-based parts cleaner to a non-hazardous parts washer with an on-site filtering system. They also offer re-refined oil to customers.

In addition to receiving their EnviroStars certification, the shop has been recognized by the Kitsap county Green Works Program as a Distinguished Business in the Green for their efforts to recycle solid waste and use recycled products.

Suquamish Auto Repair's efforts to use less toxic products, recycle, and reduce or properly manage hazardous waste are practices that prevent pollution and protect the health of Kitsap County residents and the environment.
