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

Kitsap County 2018 Healthy Youth Survey participation rates: 6^{th} grade -2,005 students (75%), 8^{th} grade -1,774 students (65%), 10^{th} grade -2,002 students (72%) and 12^{th} grade -1,433 students (48%).

Kitsap County Current Alcohol Use Over Time








